St Mellitus College (SMC) was formed in 2007 by the Bishops of London and Chelmsford working in partnership with St Paul's Theological Centre (Holy Trinity Brompton). It now delivers non-residential, full-time and part-time training in theology and ministry at both undergraduate and postgraduate level, preparing students for ordained, Reader (LLM) and lay ministries in the Church of England, and for leadership in other churches. In 2013, St Mellitus North West was launched, in partnership with five dioceses in the NW of England. Last year St Mellitus South West launched in partnership with the dioceses of Exeter and Truro.

St Mellitus College, South West is situated at St Matthias Church, North Hill (PL4 8HF). The teaching day in Plymouth is Tuesday 8.30am – 4.30pm.
